The present deliverable is meant to report the first dissemination event organized by "Friedrich Schiller" Gymnasium to mark the launch of the project, **European values are all RIGHT** (**Romanian, Italian, Greek-Hellenic, Turkish**), Erasmus + Project on Strategic Partnership for School Education in 2018, the Year of European Cultural Heritage.

The event which took place on 2nd October 2018 was aimed at presenting the project to a broader public. The event gathered around 50 participants, representing the public authorities at the national (officials of the Ministry of Education), and local level (The General School Inspectorate), teachers and mass - media. The activity was opened by a artistic moment that resembled the multiculturalism characteristic of our institution, embedding the German, Hungarian and Romanian traditions through traditional dances and costumes.

The presentation of the project shortly followed with expanding on the objectives of this project which are the acquisition by the participants of a set of values and of the afferent behavioral patterns based on the viewpoints of the orthodox, catholic and muslim religions, the conversion of these behavioral patterns into active democratic and multicultural civic engagement patterns adapted to the European framework of the 21st century, as well as the development of active citizenship and entrepreneurship based on the spiritual values of these religions. The presentation was made by Franciska Zsigmond PhD, and school principal Dana Bendris.

The project had positive feedback from most of the participants as well as the State Secretary who appreciated our initiative on gathering different cultural and religious backgrounds to promote the development of the education and to contour solid and healthy identities.
