Negative form:

Subject	+	do / does	+	not	+	base form of the verb
↓		↓		↓		↓
I		do		not		play.
				don't		
He		does		not		run.
				doesn't		

Interrogative form:

Do / Does	+	subject	+	base form of the verb?
↓		↓		↓
Does		he		play?
Do		they		eat?

Short answers:

Yes,	+	subject	+	do / does.
No,	+	subject	+	don't / doesn't.

Yes, I / you / we / they do. Yes, he / she / it does.
No, I / you / we / they don't. No, he / she / it doesn't.
