Present Continuous with a future meaning

We can use the **present continuous** to talk about arrangements (plans which you have organised) in the future (jövőre tervezett cselekvések).

My brother **is playing** football with his friends tonight.



I'm going to the cinema at the weekend.

Are you **having** a party <u>next Saturday</u>?

<u>Time expressions</u> used with present continuous:	
to talk about future plans (jövőbeli tervek)	to talk about actions in progress (folyamatban
 this afternoon, tomorrow morning, next week, in two years, etc. 	levő cselekvések) - now, right now, at the moment
I'm playing football tomorrow afternoon.	I'm playing football now.

<u>Time expressions</u> used with present continuous:

- **to talk about future plans** (jövőbeli tervek): this afternoon, tomorrow morning, next week, in two years, etc.
- **to talk about actions in progress** (folyamatban levő cselekvések): now, right now, at the moment
