The words **a** and **an** are **articles**.

We use **a** before a naming word that starts with a consonant (b c d f g h j k l m n p q r s t v w x y z).

We use **an** before a naming word that starts with a vowel (a e i o u).

A and **an** tell us that the naming word is single in number.
