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Present Simple

The sun **rises** in the east.



The stars **come** out at night.



I **eat** an apple every day.



She **wakes** up at 6 o'clock in the morning.



Look at the words in colour above. They are **verbs**. They tell about actions.

Verbs have tenses. A tense tells about the time.

The coloured verbs above are in the **present simple** tense.

We use the **present simple** to talk about things we do regularly, or things which are always true.

I eat an apple every day. (regular action)

The sun rises in the east. (always true)

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Present Continuous



The boy is telling lies to his mother. What are they really doing? Look at the picture and say.

We use the **present continuous** for actions happening right now.
