

Simple Past Tense



Positive Sentences → Subject + V2

- We **watched** the news last night.
- They **went** to the party yesterday.
- She **read** the book.

Negative Sentences → Subject + did not + V1

- We **did not (didn't) watch** the news last night.
- They **did not (didn't) go** to the party yesterday.
- She **did not (didn't) read** the book.

Question Sentences → Did + Subject + V1

- **Did** we **watch** the news last night?
- **Did** they **go** to the party yesterday?
- **Did** she **read** the book?

Past Continuous Tense



Positive Sentences → **Subject + BE(was/were) + Ving**

- You **were watching** television last night.
- They **were studying** math yesterday.
- I **was washing** the dishes when the phone rang.

Negative Sentences → **Subject + BE(was/were) NOT + Ving**

- You **were not (weren't) watching** television last night.
- They **were not (weren't) studying** math yesterday.
- I **was not (wasn't) washing** the dishes when the phone rang.

Question Sentences → **BE(was/were) + Subject + Ving**

- **Were you watching** television last night?
- **Were they studying** math yesterday?
- **Was I washing** the dishes when the phone rang?
